Instructions: The numbers in the gray area represent “parts”. For example, for Swatch No. 2 / Orange you need 1 part Yellow and 1 part Red. Depending on the total quantity you need, one part could be a drop or a tea spoon, or as big as one liter. Here is a spreadsheet to help you with this:

Tips for making custom colors: Start with the *accent* color **then** add small quantity of the *main* color at a time. Never pour dye directly from the bottle as you may easily put too much. Use a small amount of dye on a piece of white paper to compare to your leather.
